

# Heat Pump Permitting Guide



#### Disclaimer

This is a reference guide for your convenience while preparing for your project. Please discuss your retrofit plans with Town staff for exact requirements, as the guidelines below are subject to change.

# Key Steps when Seeking Your Permit(s)

#### **Before Completing Permit Applications**

- Review rebate opportunities: Some funding programs require rebate applications be approved before retrofits begin
- Are you in a Development Permit Area? <u>If yes</u>, see "Get a Development Permit" below
  - Check the Official Community Plan
- What are the zoning requirements for your property?
- Does the proposed location for your heat pump comply with Sidney's setback requirements? <u>If no</u>, see "Get a Development Variance Permit" below
  - A heat pump cannot be closer than 3m to any lot line
  - See the Zoning Bylaw for additional zoning requirements (e.g. setbacks required for your property's zone)
- Do you live in a strata?
  - If yes, you will need strata approval and submit a Strata Approval Letter with your application(s)

### Apply for a Building Permit

- Are you putting in a ductless heat pump or a ducted heat pump?
  - Ductless: talk to the Building Official
  - Ducted: See below

#### Building Permit Requirements

- Completed Building Permit application form
- Proposed system specifications
- TECA Mechanical Ventilation Checklist
- Two hard copies of a site plan
  - + Digital copies of all plans submitted
- Title search
  - Must have been obtained within 14 days before application submitted
- Pay application fee: variable depending on project cost See Building Bylaw 2016



# Heat Pump Permitting Guide Continued

#### Apply for a Development Permit (if needed)

- Check in with Town staff
- Determine if a variance is needed
  - o If yes, see "Apply for a Variance Permit" below

#### Development Permit Requirements

- Completed Development Permit application form
- Site plan
  - show setbacks and screening
- Elevation plans
  - show screening
- Title search
  - Must have been obtained within 14 days before application submitted
- Pay application fee: See Fee Schedule (\$150 as of Aug 2022)

#### Apply for a Variance Permit (if needed)

- Check in with Town staff
- If a Development Permit is also needed, then these two applications are submitted together

#### Development Variance Permit Requirements

- Letter of rationale for variance
- Pay fee for application: See Fee Schedule (\$250 as of Aug 2022)
- strule Please note: all applications will take time to review, process, and approve strule

# **Zoning Bylaw Excerpt (for reference)**

#### Section 5.1.12 Heat Pumps

- a. When placed at grade or wall mounted, heat pumps and central air conditioning units shall:
  - i. Only be located in the rear yard or interior side yard
  - ii. Not be closer than 3 meters from any lot line
- b. Heat pumps located on the roof of a building shall
  - i. Be screened from view of adjacent properties and the street by the roof structure or parapet walls
